

STADE EMPLOYEES SWAB TO SAVE LIVES

This sustainability story is one of many that shows how Olin products, technologies, ideas, and people are having a positive impact on our world.

SUSTAINABILITY CHALLENGE

- Over 900,000 people worldwide are diagnosed with blood cancers every year.
- Just 6 out of 10 people with blood cancer are able to find a matching donor for life-saving treatment.

OLIN'S SOLUTION

- DKMS is an international nonprofit organization founded in Germany to fight blood cancers by registering potential stem cell donors in a global database.
- Since 1991, DKMS has registered 7.9 million donors.
- In December 2019, Olin's Stade employees held a campaign to register potential donors with DKMS.

POSITIVE IMPACT

- The stem cell donor campaign in Stade has helped raise awareness that a simple swab test can lead to life-saving treatment.
- More than 50 Stade employees registered as potential stem cell donors, which eventually could lead to many opportunities to give others a second chance at life.
