This sustainability story is one of many that shows how Olin products, technologies, ideas, and people are having a positive impact on our world.

SUSTAINABILITY CHALLENGE

- Olin's Russellville Cell Services team makes polymer concrete used to cast new cell parts.
- Each cast requires the team to make slightly more concrete than needed to successfully cast.
- The extra concrete was sent to a landfill for disposal.

POSITIVE IMPACT

- More than 500 barriers are donated each year, saving more than \$40,000 for community organizations.
- The team's creativity avoids approximately 62 tons of landfill waste each year.

OLIN'S SOLUTION

- The team created a special mold to use the excess concrete to produce small parking space barriers.
- All barriers are then donated to local churches and schools.
